Artworks!

• A three-event fundraiser in April that allows us to provide fine arts, music, theater, dance, library books, art & innovation supplies, teacher professional development, garden, supplemental class materials, technology, and so much more. Past programs have included Drama Education Network, We Tell Stories, Symphonic Jazz Orchestra, origami, dance, and more.

Community Arts Day:

• A free, family-friendly, daytime event celebrating the visual and performing arts that includes hands-on workshops, performances, art happenings, and more.

Artworks! Fiesta:

• A grown-ups only evening with music, dinner, and silent and live auctions.

Artworks! Auction:

- Over 200 items including fine art, gift cards, tickets to museums and sporting events, rare collector's items, and special experiences.
- Live, silent, and online auctions we have it all!

After School Programs

• There are a variety of programs offered for students before and after school:

Culver City Afterschool Recreation Program (CCARP):

• Run by Culver City's Parks and Recreation department, this <u>program</u> takes place at Lindberg park.

Office of Childhood Development (OCD):

• This before and after school <u>program</u> takes place at Farragut's campus.

Spotlight Enrichment:

- After-school enrichment classes that take place Fall, Winter, and Spring.
- Visual Arts * Sports * Performing Arts * Lego Engineering * Mad Science * Critter Academy * AND MORE!

Youth Sports Enrichment (YSE):

• Also run by Culver City's Parks and Recreation department, this <u>program</u> focuses on youth sports.

Assemblies

Monthly Morning Assemblies:

- The first Monday of the month
- 8:45 am on the blacktop
- The principal & school leaders make important & fun announcements.

Student Only Assemblies:

• Fun and enriching PTA-sponsored performances during the school day for all children, often featuring music, dance, improv, and more!

Back-To-School Day/Night

• In early September, this parent/guardian-only event provides the first opportunity to get a glimpse of your child's classroom and hear from your child's teacher about the upcoming year. Usually it's held after school, but in recent years it was held during the day after drop-off.

Backpacks for Kids Program

- CCUSD runs a weekly backpack program to ensure that every child can eat on the weekends.
- Backpacks are filled with non-perishable food and snacks for children to take home over the weekend. There is no cost for Farragut families to participate and enrollment is 100% confidential.
- Children return backpacks to school by Tuesday so that they can be refilled for Friday pick up.

Book Fair

- Takes place for an entire week in November, in the library, to give families an opportunity to browse and buy some amazing books!
- During the week, each class will have a chance to visit the fair. The fair will also be open to families during drop-off and pick-up. Kick-start your child's love of reading while benefiting our PTA!

Career Day

- Usually in May, parents are encouraged to come give a short presentation to your child's class or at a class assembly!
- All professions welcome: writers, CEOs, fire chiefs, composers, police officers, engineers, scientists, and more!

Choir & Bells

- Retired Farragut teacher Mrs. Eskridge leads interested Foxes in these optional and FREE musical endeavors.
- Practice before school on Monday or Wednesday morning.
- Two concert performances (winter & spring) every school year!

Direct Donation Campaign

- Our annual direct fundraising effort starts every fall and continues all year.
- There is NO MINIMUM donation.
- Money raised through Direct Donation allows us to provide exciting programs for our children including art, drama, music, computers, technology, garden, dance, and beyond.

Fan Club

- Fan Club raises funds during the year through direct donations, Artworks!, FoxTrot, and various other events. With these funds, Fan Club pays for Art & Innovation supplies, Technology, Library & Class Room Books, Teacher Professional Development, Garden, Supplemental Class Materials, PE supplies, Theater and Dance programs and many more!

PTA

- The Farragut Parent Teacher Association (PTA) is a unit of the California and National PTA. The PTA's purpose is to promote the education, health, and welfare of children and youth in home, school and community.
- Farragut PTA raises funds during the year through book fairs, a gift wrap sale, the Fall Festival, and various other events. With these funds, the PTA pays for educational field trips, assemblies, the Home Reading Program, and other classroom needs.

PTA/Fan Club Monthly Meetings

• The second Thursday of the month, open to all members of the Farragut community. Come learn about what's happening at Farragut, including financial allocations & program additions/revisions, and have a VOICE in those decisions!

Room Representatives

School Site Council

- Comprised of parents, teachers, school staff members and the principal, this group discusses the school site plan, school-wide goals for improvement, and the school safety plan.
