- April 2022

Student Council

- Being part of the Student Council is a wonderful experience for students to play an active role in the school community and develop leadership skills.

Teacher Appreciation Breakfasts & Teacher Appreciation Week

- Each grade hosts a Teacher Appreciation Breakfast, starting with 5th grade in October and finishing with Kindergarten in May.
- Parents sign up to bring specific items from a provided list in order to make a wonderful breakfast for Farragut teachers and staff.
- Each grade hosts only once, and for the entire staff, not just your child's grade level.
- The first week of May, Farragut celebrates Teacher Appreciation Week with a luncheon and other events throughout the week.

Walk 'n' Rollers

- Take the 3-block challenge and walk, bike, skate or scoot to school!
- Walk 'n' Rollers Day happens once a month (in conjunction with Spirit Day & Popsicle Day). It's a friendly competition to see which class has the most kids getting to school courtesy of their own two feet!
