

Volunteering at Farragut



Farragut LOVES and NEEDS its many volunteers!

All volunteers must obtain clearance before they can help out on campus during school hours.

The clearance process is as follows:

1. Attend a volunteer orientation (led by Principal Masterson) and receive a packet.
2. Provide paperwork showing a cleared TB test. (This step can be done before orientation.)
3. Complete the volunteer packet.
4. Bring completed packet to the Farragut office (by appointment) and receive final documents for fingerprinting.
5. Go to a Live Scan vendor as directed for fingerprinting.
6. Check with the front office to see if you have been cleared.
7. Clearance status typically lasts for the duration of your child's time as a CCUSD student.
