FIRST: The name of this corporation is Farragut School Booster Club.

SECOND: This corporation is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any one person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

FOURTH: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles:

(a) This corporation is not organized, nor shall it be operated, for pecuniary gain or profit, and it does contemplate the distribution of gains, profits or dividends to any individual,

its members or to any private shareholder, as defined for purpose of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and is organized solely for non-profit and charitable purposes, pursuant to applicable State law.

- (b) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propagands or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this Corporation participate or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- (c) This Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on
  (i) by a cosporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501: (c) (3) of the
  Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any figure United
  States Internal Revenue Law), or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are
  deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the
  corresponding polyision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (iii) under
  comparable laws that statutes of the State of California.

- (d) The property, assets, profits and net income of this Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever insure to the benefit of any director, trustee, officer, shareholder or member of any corporation, or to the benefit of any private individual.
- e) On the dissolution, liquidation, abandonment or winding up of this Corporation its assets (other than assets held in trust) remaining after payment of all its debts and liabilities shall be distributed by the Board of Directors to FARRAGUT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL or its Parent-Teacher Association or, only if that is not permitted by law or is otherwise impossible, to non-profit funds foundations or corporation organized and operate exclusively for charitable purposes and which have established their tax-exempt status under Section (501)(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954. If this corporation holds any assets in trust, they shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the Superior Court of the County of which the principal office of this corporation is located, on petition therefore by the Attorney General of the State of California of by any person concerned in the liquidation and dissolution thereof.
