

Volunteering at Farragut



Farragut LOVES and NEEDS its many volunteers!

All volunteers must obtain clearance before they can help out on campus during school hours.

The clearance process is as follows:

1. Attend a volunteer orientation led by the Principal/Staff
2. Complete the volunteer packet
 - a. Download and print a volunteer packet [here](#)
 - b. Provide paperwork showing a cleared TB test.
 - c. Bring completed packet to the Farragut office along with your drivers license and covid vaccine information and receive final documents for fingerprinting.
 - d. Go to a Live Scan vendor as directed for fingerprinting.
3. Check with the front office to see if you have been cleared.
4. Clearance status typically lasts for the duration of your child's time as a CCUSD student.

Taxes done Eze on Sepulveda (11477 Jefferson Blvd., Culver City, 90232) offers **free** livescans for CCUSD. Volunteers will need to inform the business staff person that the live scan is for CCUSD, and CCUSD will be billed for the service.
